Part 172, Subpart H of the Department of Transportation's Title 49 CFR requires initial and recurrent training at least every 3 years.

Who Should attend?

Anyone who:

Designs-Represents-Modifies-Repairs-Marks-Manufactures-Prepares-Reconditions-Tests-Ships Hazardous Materials Packaging.

Why Attend?

Failure to meet the DOT Training requirements in 49 CFR, Part 172, Subpart H, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties of up to \$50,000 per violation. **IT'S THE LAW!**

Human error is the number one cause of hazardous materials incidents. The U.S. Department of Transportation requires employers take a systematic training approach to ensure hazmat employees:

- Are familiar with the general hazardous materials requirements;
- Can recognize and identify hazardous materials;
- Know the specific hazardous materials requirements applicable to the job function;
- Are aware of emergency response information, self protective measures and accident prevention measures.

Training cost includes:

A training manual, a current copy of Title 49 CFR, and a copy of the General Security Awareness CD published by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

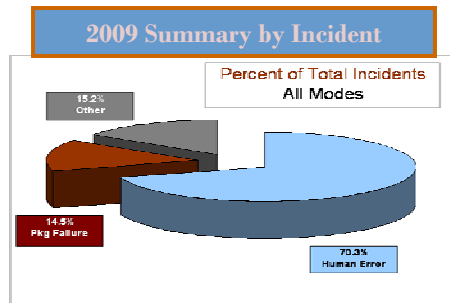
