Part 172, Subpart H of DOT's Title 49 CFR requires initial training with 90 days of employment or change in job function and every 3 years thereafter.

Designs—Represents—Modifies—Repairs—Marks—Manufactures—Prepares—Reconditions—Tests—Ships
Hazardous Materials Packaging

Why attend?

Failure to meet the DOT training requirements in 49 CFR, Part 172, Subpart H, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties.
