Why Attend?

Failure to meet the DOT Training requirements in 49 CFR, Part 172, Subpart H, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties of up to \$50,000 per violation.

Training with a focus on the requirements for packaging and packages intended to transport Hazardous Materials.

Is Training Critical to YOUR Business?

Human error is the number one cause of hazardous materials incidents. The U.S. Department of Transportation requires employers take a systematic training approach to ensure hazmat employees:

- Are familiar with the general hazardous materials requirements;
- Can recognize and identify hazardous materials;
- Know the specific hazardous materials requirements applicable to the job function;
- Are aware of emergency response information, self protective measures and accident prevention measures.
